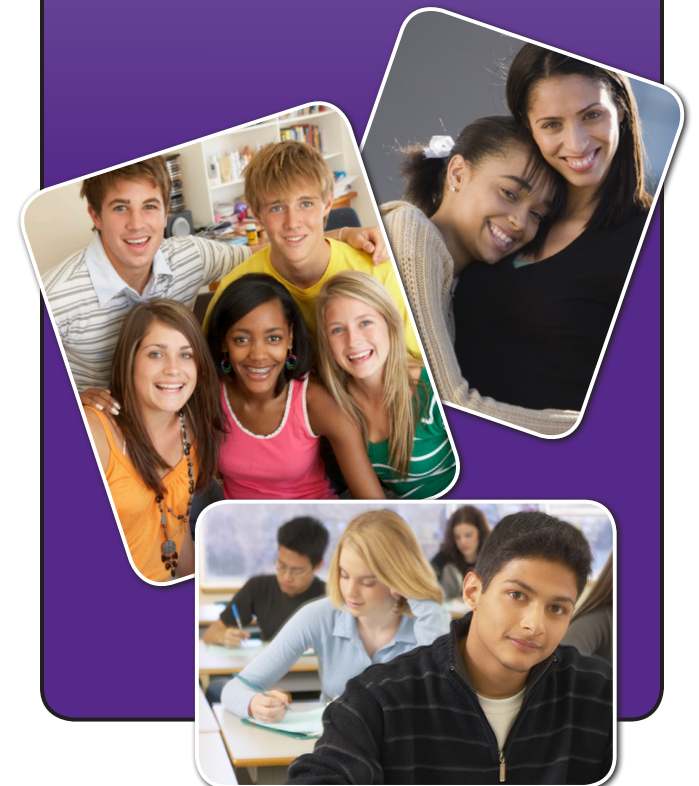

Since 2005, Team 10 Drug Free Coalition (Team 10)

has served the communities of Collinsville, Maryville, Caseyville, Fairmont City and the unincorporated areas served by Collinsville Community Unit School District #10 (CUSD10).

As of 2008, Team 10 has been funded by a Drug Free Communities Grant Support Program from the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) and the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMSHA).

Funds are being used to accomplish the following goals:

- To increase and strengthen collaboration among Team 10's partner organizations in support of the community's efforts to prevent and reduce substance abuse among youth.
- To reduce substance use among youth in the Collinsville, Maryville, Caseyville, Fairmont City and the unincorporated areas served by CUSD10 by addressing community issues that increase the risk of substance abuse and promoting the factors that minimize the risk of substance abuse.

TEAM 10's MISSION is to foster a healthy, drug-free environment for adults and youth in the Collinsville Unit 10 School District Communities by promoting and supporting effective systems and programs.

The coalition is working toward this mission by:

1. Building relationships with community members and leaders
2. Encouraging and promoting community participation and leadership with Team 10
3. Addressing how and where youth are getting alcohol, tobacco and other drugs from within the community
4. Strengthening the expression of the community norm against underage drinking and underage drinking parties
5. Helping people understand the risks involved with alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use, especially among youth
6. Working with various agencies and police departments to provide an Unwanted Medication Disposal Program and Alcohol Compliance Checks
7. Providing support for local, safe, drug-free family and youth events such as SplashDown, an annual back to school event at Splash City
8. Providing the school district with prevention resources and additional student drug testing kits
